

SPECIAL BULLETIN – MARCH 13, 2020

On behalf of Lautrec, Ltd., the health and safety of our residents and employees is of the utmost importance to us. We are recommending that everyone do what is in their best interests to protect themselves from exposure to the COVID-19 (“coronavirus”) virus. This includes following the guidance by the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) as well as any provincial governmental agencies.

We also encourage the precautions that the PHAC is recommending for social distancing and limiting group gatherings whenever possible. **Therefore, we are suspending all group events, NO EXCEPTIONS, within our Communities until further notice.** We appreciate your patience regarding this decision as we assist in maintaining the health of our residents and employees. In an effort to further minimize person-to-person contact, we encourage residents to limit unnecessary face-to-face contact with other residents as well as employees. In this regard, we encourage our residents to curtail their use of our clubhouses, fitness centers and other amenities.

We encourage our residents to communicate with the Community Office via telephone and pay their rent via Canada Post.

Please be reminded of the following everyday precautions recommended by the PHAC:

- ◆ If you have traveled to a location where the coronavirus is present or been in contact with a person known to have contracted the virus, please self-quarantine and refrain from utilizing Community common areas.
- ◆ Clean your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing or being in a public place. Use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap is not available.
- ◆ To the extent possible, avoid touching high-touch surfaces in public places including elevator buttons, door handles and handrails. Use a tissue or your sleeve to cover your hand or finger if you must touch something.
- ◆ **If you are sick, please stay home!**
